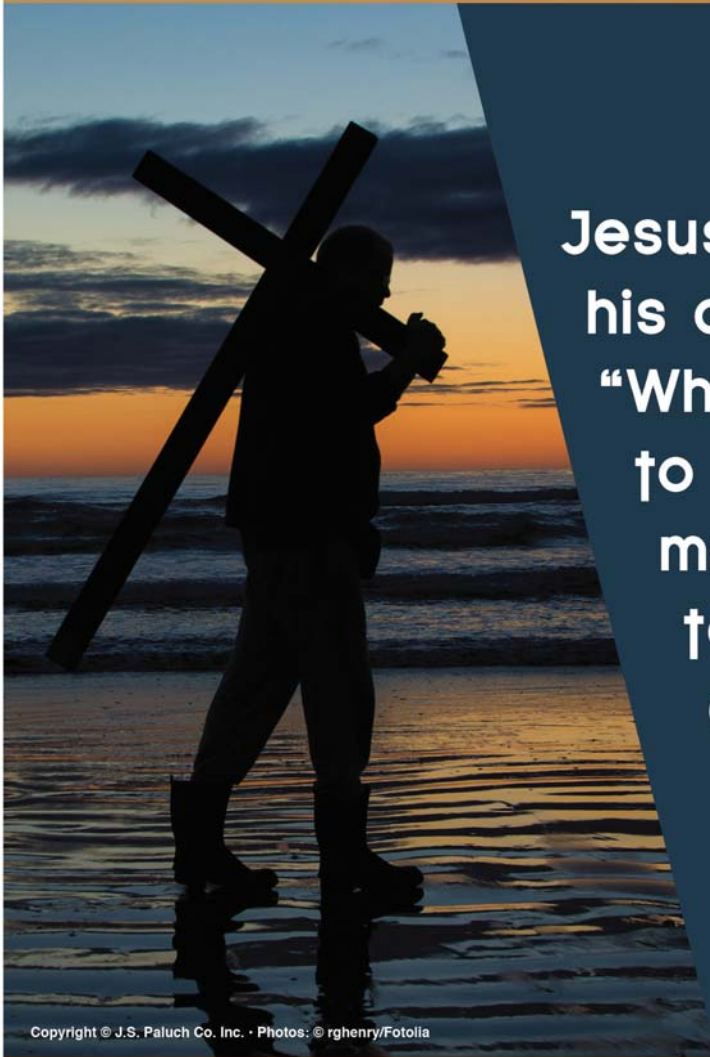

1. This Monday is *Labor Day* which marks the unofficial end of summer, and a beginning of our Fall calendar. The first two events occur back-to-back. Next Sunday is the celebration of *Hispanic Heritage* month, which begins with our 11:00am Mass, and is followed by activities, fun and fellowship in Hunter Hall and the backyard. We will include some prayers, songs, and a reading in Spanish for the occasion, and hopefully many of you will be able to stop by to enjoy the food and entertainment.
2. The day after Sunday's celebration, we will begin set-up for our *Fall Rummage and Bake Sale*. Tables will be arranged in the morning, so probably starting Monday afternoon you can drop off items for the rummage sale. We hope that the items you donate would be in good working order, and any clothing would be washed before you drop them off. The sale itself is set for September 21-23. In preparation for the rummage sale the Women's Club will meet this Thursday at 12noon for a meeting. The rosary will be said at 11:30am in Church.
3. This weekend the Women's Club begins their September *Membership Drive*, which takes place after all the weekend Masses and will continue until the end of the month.

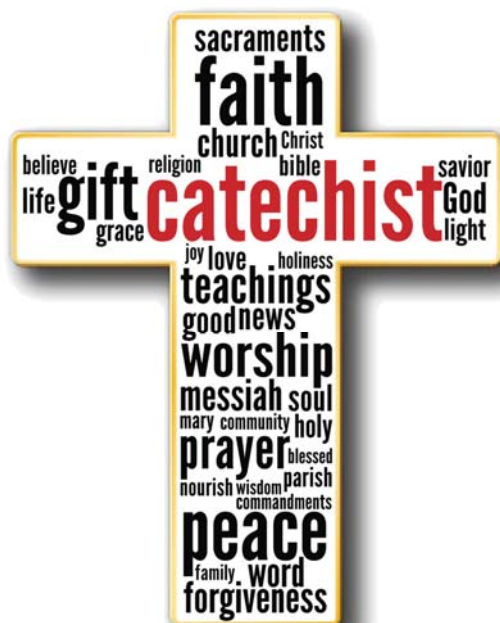


CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

How Will You Serve?

Last months stewardship article introduced the concept of us as God's distributors of the gifts He has bestowed upon each of us. So, how do we do this? How can we love and serve God by loving and serving one another?
